

## Cairo Slums Get Energy Makeover



Just such an effort to address the cook stove problem was launched Tuesday by the United Nations Foundation, the nonprofit begun by media billionaire Ted Turner to support the UN in its work. Secretary of State Hillary Clinton announced a \$50 million U.S. contribution to the public-private partnership, the Global Alliance for Clean Cook stoves.

In addition to biogas digesters, potential solutions include advanced biomass cook stoves that greatly reduce the products of incomplete combustion, and stoves that use liquefied petroleum gas, or LPG (of which propane is a form).
